









Knowledge Translation

"The synthesis, exchange, and application of knowledge by relevant stakeholders to accelerate the benefits of global and local innovation in strengthening health systems and improving people's health"




Models of Knowledge Translation


Burden of Disease

- Interpretation of Disability-Adjusted Life Years (DALY) is difficult
 - Not only for policy makers
- Complex calculation of a DALY
 - Many choices to be made
- A lot of data
 - Needed for the calculations
 - And as a result
 (sex, age, disease, risk factor, year, countries)



Burden of Disease and push model




• When: policy cycle

- > How to engage stakeholders?
